The MiniEines project promotes primary production and processing of edible insects in Northern Ostrobothnia, Finland. The main target group consists of the region's rural (agricultural/horticultural) and food businesses. The project is implemented between October 2018 and December 2020.

- To raise awareness of emerging, developing and expanding rural businesses on the opportunities of insect production as a business.
- To raise awareness of food businesses on the opportunities of edible insects as raw materials.
